Temporary Road Closure

2024 Bathurst Superfest

Track Closure: The Mount Panorama Motor Racing Circuit will be closed and traffic will be controlled for Bathurst Superfest, from approximately **7am Wednesday 14 February to approximately 12pm Monday 26 February 2024** (inclusive), to control the movement of spectators:

Mountain Straight: just above the entrance to the Paddock Camping Area

Conrod Straight: just above Murray's Corner.

Persons with the correct ticketing/accreditation wishing to gain access to the Track should enter via Panorama Avenue and Pit Straight.

This access is to be used by all persons with proper accreditation wishing to gain access to the Circuit.

Admission gates commence operations from **7am Friday 16 February to 5pm Sunday 18 February 2024**. (Please note admission gates open **4.30am Sunday 18 February 2024**). Then again from **7am Friday 23 February to 5pm Sunday 25 February 2024**.

Residents: Barriers will be set up at Murray's Corner and Mountain Straight with security arrangements for residents to proceed to their homes.

Council advises that the following closures and changes to traffic conditions will be in place for the **CBD events and activations** as part of the Bathurst SuperFest event.

- Closure of **Russell Street, between William Street and George Street** (access to Court House Lane will be maintained) from **6am Monday 19 February to 6pm Friday 23 February 2024**.
- Closure of **Church Street between William Street and George Street** from **12noon to 9pm Thursday 22 February 2024**
- Closure of **Durham Street between Havannah Street and Kendall Avenue (GWH)** from approximately **12noon to 4.15pm Wednesday 21 February 2024**.
- **No parking** along various sections of **William Street between Great Western Highway and Russell Street** from **5am to approximately 4.30pm Wednesday 21 February 2024**.
- **No parking** on **Durham Street between Havannah Street and Kendall Avenue (GWH)** from **7am Wednesday 21 February 2024**.
- **No parking** along **Church Street from 7am Thursday 22 February 2024**.

The CPP is a document that identifies how and when Council will engage with the Bathurst Community whilst undertaking its relevant planning functions under the Environmental Planning and Assessment Act 1979.

The purpose of the amendment is to remove the requirements to advertise planning matters in a newspaper (noting that public notice in the future will be via Council's website) and to ensure the document remains consistent with the Act.
