Temporary Road Closures Ribbon Gang Lane

Ribbon Gang Lane will be closed from Thursday 20 March 2025 for a period of approximately 12 weeks. During this time access will be maintained for pedestrians and adjacent properties.

The temporary closure is for scaffolding works completed by DSL Construction with enquiries to be directed to 0400 096 505.

Armada Bathurst Shopping Centre Bus Stop Closure

The bus stop outside Armada Bathurst Shopping Centre in Howick Street is **closed until 19 May 2025** while the existing shelter is upgraded.

A temporary bus stop has been set up in Bentinck Street, near the corner of Howick Street for the duration of the works.

The works include the removal of the existing bus shelter and installing a new structure with upgraded seating, signage and roofing.

2025 Bathurst NRL Match

Council advises that the following closures and changes to traffic conditions will be in place from 6am to 9pm on Saturday 24 May 2025 for the Bathurst NRL match at Carrington Park.

- **Closure** of Howick Street, between Bentinck Street and Seymour Street.
- **Closure** of the southbound traffic on Durham Street, between the Bathurst Visitor Information Centre entrance and Havannah Street.
- **No parking** along the Great Western Highway, between Durham Street and Havannah Street.
- **No parking** along the Northern side of Howick Street, between Seymour Street and Havannah Street.
- Resident access will be available during the closure.

The Draft Long Term Financial Plan (LTFP) 2025-2035 is a ten-year view of Council's finances and has been developed under the NSW Government's Integrated Planning and Reporting (IP&R) Framework.

The Delivery Program & Operational Plan, incorporating the Revenue Policy, outlines the strategies and financial resources required over the next four years to implement the key directions identified by the community in the draft Bathurst Community Strategic Plan 2025-2045.

At the Council Meeting held Wednesday 16 April 2025, Council resolved to place the following documents on public exhibition for a minimum of 28 days:

1. Draft Long Term Financial Plan 2025-2035
2. Draft Delivery Program 2025-2029
3. Operational Plan 2025-2026

Draft Bathurst Regional Council Local Approvals Policy 2025

At the Council meeting held on 16 April 2025, the Draft Local Approvals Policy 2025 was presented and adopted for display and public submissions. The purpose of the Local Approvals Policy (LAP) is to specify the circumstances where council approval is not required before carrying out an activity as well outlining the criteria that will be considered in determining an application. It addresses activities such as footway dining, applications relating to public roads, the installation or operation of domestic waste treatment devices, community events, street stalls, busking, fundraising or any other activities on community land and operation of manufactured home estates, caravan parks or camping grounds.
