Temporary Road Closure 2024 Hi-Tec Oils Bathurst 6 Hour

The Mount Panorama Motor Racing Circuit will be under traffic control from **8am Wednesday 27 March 2024**. Full Circuit closure will commence **6am Friday 29 March 2024 until midnight Monday 1 April 2024**, with access for accredited persons only and admission gates operating for public viewing from 8am.
