Temporary Road Closure

Night works - Waterworks Lane, Gormans Hill

Council advises that **Waterworks Lane** at the corner of Gormans Hill Road will be **closed** to traffic on **Wednesday night 24 January from 6.15pm to approximately 4am on Thursday 25 January 2024.**

This is to allow a water main to be installed across the road.

Traffic and residents can use Lyal Street to access and egress Waterworks Lane during this period.

Gormans Hill Road will remain open for traffic.

2024 Bathurst Superfest

Track Closure: The Mount Panorama Motor Racing Circuit will be closed and traffic will be controlled for Bathurst Superfest, from approximately 7am Wednesday 14 February to approximately 12pm Monday 26 February 2024 (inclusive), to control the movement of spectators:

 $\underline{\mbox{Mountain Straight:}} \mbox{ just above the entrance to the Paddock Camping Area}$

Conrod Straight: just above Murray's Corner.

Persons with the correct ticketing/accreditation wishing to gain access to the Track should enter via Panorama Avenue and Pit Straight.

This access is to be used by all persons with proper accreditation wishing to gain access to the Circuit.

Admission gates commence operations from 7am Friday 16 February to 5pm Sunday 18 February 2024. (Please note admission gates open 4.30am Sunday 18 February 2024). Then again from 7am Friday 23 February to 5pm Sunday 25 February 2024.

Residents: Barriers will be set up at Murray's Corner and Mountain Straight with security arrangements for residents to proceed to their homes.

Conrod Straight, Mount Panorama

A section of Conrod Straight (between Marshal Point 19.1 and 19.7) will be closed to traffic on **Tuesday 23 January 2024** between 8am and 11am for filming activity.

The remainder of the circuit remains unaffected.

Liberty A-league Match

Council advises that the following closures and changes to traffic conditions will be in place on **Friday 9 February 2024** between **6am and 10pm** for the Liberty A-League match at Carrington Park.

Closure of Howick Street, between Bentinck Street and Seymour Street.

Closure of the southbound traffic on Durham Street, between the Bathurst Visitor Information Centre entrance and Havannah Street.

No parking along the Northern side of Howick Street, between Seymour Street and Havannah Street.

No parking along the <u>Great Western Highway</u>, between <u>Durham Street</u> and <u>Havannah Street</u>.
