Temporary Road Closure

2024 Repco Bathurst 1000

Track Closures: The **Mount Panorama Motor Racing Circuit** will be closed from approximately **6am on Saturday 6 October to 2pm Monday 14 October 2024**, to control the movement of spectators:

- Mountain Straight – just above the entrance to the Paddock Camping Area.
- Conrod Straight – just above Murray's Corner.

Persons wishing to gain access to the Track should enter via Panorama Avenue and Pit Straight.

Admission gates commence operations from approximately **7am on Thursday 10 October until Sunday 13 October 2024**.

Traffic Management Plan: **Traffic will be controlled on Panorama Avenue, Havannah Street and Lloyds Road** from approximately **5am on Thursday 10 October until 2pm Monday 14 October 2024**.

Residents: Under direction from the Clerk of the Course, access for residents will be facilitated through Murray's Corner at specific breaks during the racing schedule. Correspondence outlining all access arrangements will be distributed to residents directly.

2024 Repco Bathurst 1000 Race Week Off Track Events

Council advises that the following closures and changes to traffic conditions will be in place for Race Week Events.

- **Closure of Russell Street and Church Street** between William Street and George Street from **6am Wednesday 9 October 2024 to 6am Thursday 10 October 2024 and 6am Friday 11 October 2024 to 6am Saturday 12 October 2024**.
- **Closure of William Street** between Church Street and Russell Street from **4.30pm to 7pm Wednesday 9 October 2024**.
- **No parking on Russell Street and Church Street** between William Street and Russell Street from **4pm Tuesday 8 October 2024 and 4pm Thursday 10 October 2024**.
- **No parking on William Street between Church Street and Russell Street** from **6am to 7.30pm Wednesday 9 October 2024**.
- **No parking on William Street between Russell Street and BMEC** from **6am to 7.30pm Wednesday 9 October 2024**.
- **Caution tape** will be in place along **William Street** between Russell and Keppel Street from **6am Wednesday 9 October 2024** for pedestrian safety and will be removed immediately after the parade has finished.
- To ensure spectators remain a safe distance from moving vehicles, **crowd control barriers** will be put in place along the **corner of Russell Street and William Street and Russell Street and George Street** from **6am Wednesday 9 October 2024**.
- **Temporary relocation** of the **Russell and Church Street Taxi Ranks to George Street** (across from the Western Advocate) on **Wednesday 9 October 2024 and Friday 11 October 2024**.
- **Disabled parking** installed on **William Street between Church Street and Howick Street** on **Wednesday 9 October 2024** and on **William Street between Church Street and Russell Street** (next to the permanent disabled parking space) on **Friday 11 October 2024**.

Bathurst Region Heritage Plan

Council's Strategic Planning Section is preparing the next update to the Bathurst Region Heritage Plan. The Plan guides heritage management within the Bathurst Region and establishes the key strategic priorities and actions for heritage management over a period of 4 years.

Heritage management includes the protection and promotion of heritage across Council's departments. Importantly, for Council to operate its Heritage Advisory services and for that service to be supported by a grant provided by Heritage NSW, Council must have an adopted Heritage Plan in place.

The current plan covers the 2021-2025 period and is due to be updated in 2025.

Council is seeking to survey a wide range of community members aiming to:

- Gauge the community's understanding of Council's heritage management practices,
- Gauge the community's current values as they relate to heritage matters,
- Understand the community's opinion on heritage related challenges,
- Discover how achievements of the Heritage Plan can be better shared with interested parties.

Notice of Proposal - Electric Vehicle Charging Infrastructure

Council has received a proposal from NRMA for a licence agreement to allow the installation and operation of electric vehicle fast charging infrastructure at the Domain Car Park on Stanley Street, Bathurst.

The Domain Carpark is a Crown Reserve (Reserve Number 66907) managed by Council under the Bathurst Regional Council - Council Managed Crown Land Plan of Management. Under this plan, car parking infrastructure, including electric vehicle charging, is a permitted purpose for which a licence can be granted in this location.

NRMA propose to install 2 x DC fast chargers and one AC destination charger, utilising 6 parking spaces. All costs associated with the installation and maintenance of the Electric Vehicle charging infrastructure will be the responsibility of NRMA. Council will negotiate a market based annual licence fee with NRMA.
