1 VARIATION TO THE ANNUAL OPERATING PLAN 2012/2013 (16.00129)

Recommendation: That Council adjust the Annual Operating Plan 2012/2013 as outlined within the report.

Report: At the Council meeting held 20 June 2012 Council agreed to vary the water charges by reducing the proposed increase from the 15% back to 5%. As a result of this Council's income from water sales was reduced by \$730,000 which needs to be deducted from the expenditure contained within the Annual Operating Plan 2012/2013.

The proposed reductions are as follows:
