### **Competition Guidelines:**

The logo must contain the wording 'Bathurst Regional Community Safety Committee'.

Flexibility is a key requirement, including the need to resize easily and look good in black and white as well as colour.

The final version of the logo will need to be suitable for high quality printing. It should be visually appealing on both small and large scales.

The competition is open to anyone residing, working or studying in the Bathurst LGA.

Contestants are permitted to work in groups, however only one prize will be awarded regardless of group size.

The winner will be contacted by Friday 23 May 2024.

**Prize:**

The winner will receive a \$500 Buy Local Gift Card.

The winner will also be presented with a letter from the BRCSC acknowledging use of the logo.

**Judging and Selection of Winner:**

The winning design will be selected by the BRCSC. Entries will be judged on their visual appeal, adherence to the competition guidelines, quality of design and ease of reproduction.

The BRCSC reserves the right to not select a winner if no suitable entries are received.
