Household Chemicals

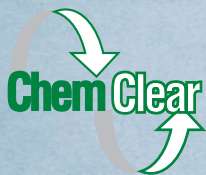
Council endeavours to have a chemical collection at least once a year. Apart from this collection, chemical disposal is available through private contractors.

Drum Muster

Drum Muster, available on the last Thursday of every month (9.00am-12.00pm) all year round, is a service for the collection and recycling of eligible* empty AgVet chemical containers.

Drums must be triple rinsed with lids removed and, if a metal drum, pierced at the base.

Major fines can be imposed by the EPA for deliberately dumping prohibited wastes in Council's landfill. For a full list of items not permitted at the WMC visit Council's website.

Vouchers

The Waste Management Centre accepts mixed waste and green waste vouchers that have been issued through Bathurst Regional Council rates notices.

Covering Loads

All loads must be covered with either a tarp or net to prevent littering. Fines may apply for not covering your load correctly.

Bathurst Regional Council does not accept material originating from outside of the Bathurst Region without written approval from the General Manager.

Waste Disposal Fees (inc. GST)

MINIMUM CHARGE - based on 20kg minimum for all per tonne waste.

Bathurst Waste Management Centre accepts general solid waste.

Mixed Waste \$242/tonne

All household and domestic waste and general solid waste.

Recyclables - Separated & Sorted

Domestic No Charge

Commercial \$53/tonne

Clean cardboard, paper, glass bottles, cans and plastic bottles.

Green Waste \$183/tonne

Clean green waste only:
Trees, stumps, grass and plant clippings.

No soil or treated timber.

Bricks & Concrete \$230/tonne

Sorted Metal \$90/tonne

Asbestos \$482/tonne

Wetted and double wrapped in plastic.
48 hour booking required: Call 6338 2855.

Wastes Requiring Immediate Burial \$482/tonne

Includes animal carcasses.
48 hour booking required: Call 6338 2855.

Cover Material \$63/tonne

Clean fill*.
*Testing of the material may be required.

Waste - Large/Bulky \$295/tonne

Large, and/or difficult to bury waste including IBC's, bulka bags and bouys.

Noxious Weeds - Separated \$110/tonne

E-Waste \$90/tonne

All domestic electronic items including TVs and printers.

Textiles \$242/tonne

Textile items including clothing and apparel (even worn or slightly damaged), shoes, blankets and towels.

Tyres

Motorcycle & Car Tyres \$19 each

Truck Tyres \$39 each

Tractor Tyres \$81 each

Mattresses \$15 each

Separated or bed base

Mobile phones and household batteries can be recycled at the Council Civic Building at no charge.

If your load contains more than 10% contamination, mixed waste charges will apply.

Any material that may be contaminated must be accompanied by acceptable test results that are within the Bathurst Landfill licence parameters. Any clean fill without test results will be treated as contaminated and will not be permitted. For more information call 6338 2855.
