Bulk Filtered Water Supply: Conditions of Use

- ALL water customers must obtain a permit to access bulk water from Bathurst Regional Council's Engineering Department. Water permits must be presented upon each purchase of water or loading of water on to a water card. Water permits are valid for the current Extreme level of water restrictions. Permits will be reviewed and may be revoked when the restriction level changes. Water permits and water cards are not transferrable.
- Water is for use INSIDE the Bathurst Regional Council Local Government Area and OUTSIDE the Bathurst urban (piped) water supply area.
- Water purchase is limited to residents, landowners and approved contractors working within the Bathurst Regional Council Local Government Area.
- When Bathurst water restrictions are in place, bulk water use must adhere to the current level of restrictions. Water for stock watering is permitted. Sanctions may apply for breach of water restrictions.
- Should circumstances exist where a customer is unable to comply with the current level of water restrictions for reasons of health, safety or extenuating circumstances, the customer may apply for an exemption as per the water restrictions policy.
- The filling of bulk water containers by residents and contractors is permitted only at the Hereford Street Standpipes. Authorised Bathurst Regional Council staff are permitted to fill from the Council Depot filling station; water must be used for approved purposes and staff must adhere to current water restrictions.
- As per the *Public Health Act 2010* and *Public Health Regulation 2012*, bulk water carters who supply water to third parties must develop and adhere to a Quality Assurance Program. Refer to *NSW Guidelines for Water Carters* for details.
- Water carters must provide Council access to their water carter log books on request.
- Users of the bulk water supply service are solely responsible for the cleanliness of containers/tanks for the filling station. Food grade hoses and fittings must be used and replaced regularly. Bathurst Regional Council has no responsibility for water quality once water leaves the standpipe.
- Council monitors potable water usage and reserves the right to cancel access to filling stations if the above conditions are not met or more substantial restrictions are applied. CCTV cameras record water filling activities at the Hereford Street Standpipes.
